Hi Guys

There has been a lot of interest from members keen to be part of this year's Postal event. I have consulted a couple of other pilots about the competition procedure and the final instructions for the day is as follows.

- 1 Fill in your nomination form and email or text back a photo of it to me as soon as possible but before the deadline of Wednesday 6pm 30th of September. (I must set up the master score sheets and contact sheets and will not have time to do this Saturday morning so don't miss the deadline for nominations)----**Send a copy of this page to your Club official to take to the comp.**
- 2 Competitors to assemble at their respective flying sites on Saturday morning the 3rd of October accompanied by a timer and or a club official (committee member if possible)
- 3 Competitors get a picture of themselves with their models and post it on the Sarina Aeromodellers group page on Facebook or text it to me. A photo is required, or your nomination will be rejected.
- 4 Competitors conduct practice flights any time and can have any number of flights up until 10.30am (no elimination heats will be scored in this competition)
- 5 At 10.30am all club officials will receive a text displaying the master score sheet listing all competitors
- 6 At 11am all competitors lift off for the one and only scoring flight (The fly off) longest flight wins.
- 7 Your club official will receive 10 minute updates as other competitors finish their flights. Your club official will be required to send in your flight time ASAP after you touch down. **This is very important as the last person in the air will not want to be struggling for unnecessary extra flight time when he has already beaten the second-place time.**
- 8 The results of the competition will be displayed on the Sarina Aeromodellers Group page and texted to all competitors ASAP after the last model touches down.

Competition Rules

- 1 The competition sequence must be followed, and entry documentation and photograph must be correct for a legitimate entry. Entries will close 6pm Wednesday the 30th September to allow scorer preparation time to set up the master documents ready for Saturday.
- 2 Models must comply with Texaco rules <https://www.maaa.asn.au/images/pdfs/Australian-Rules-S5-Old-Timer-Rules-2017.pdf>
- 3 Only one flight is to be made starting at 11am. Fuel allocation as per normal and as per the rules
- 4 No attempts allowed (no restarts after the model is released on the ground)
- 5 There will be no entry fee and the trophy will not be delivered to the winner. A name plate as normal will be fitted to the trophy base indicating the winner of the 2020 Texaco championship
- 6 The weather at your location is luck of the draw so please take it on the chin if it is poor.
