1/2A Texaco Opener Results

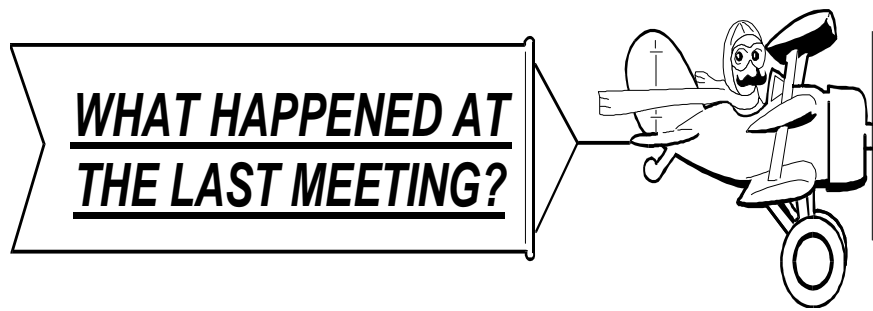
