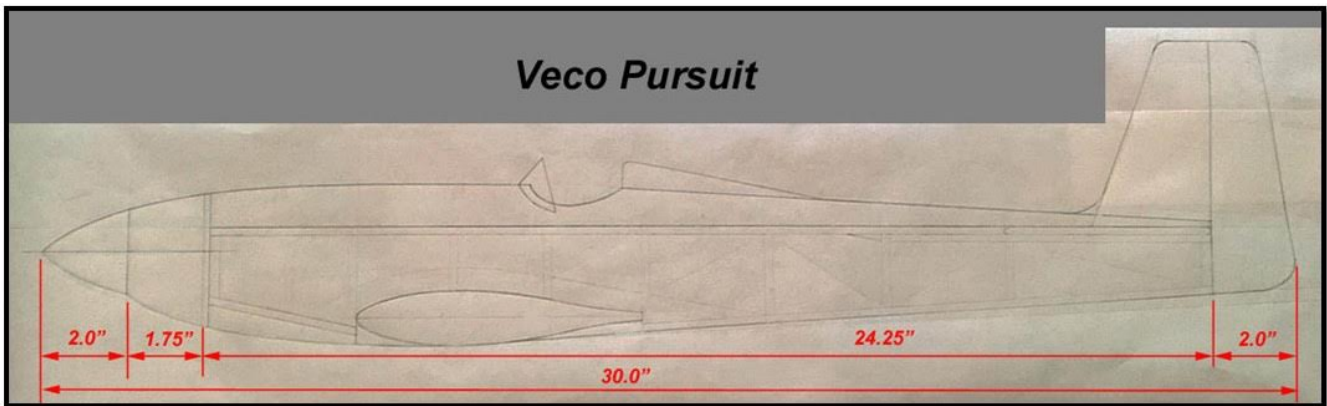

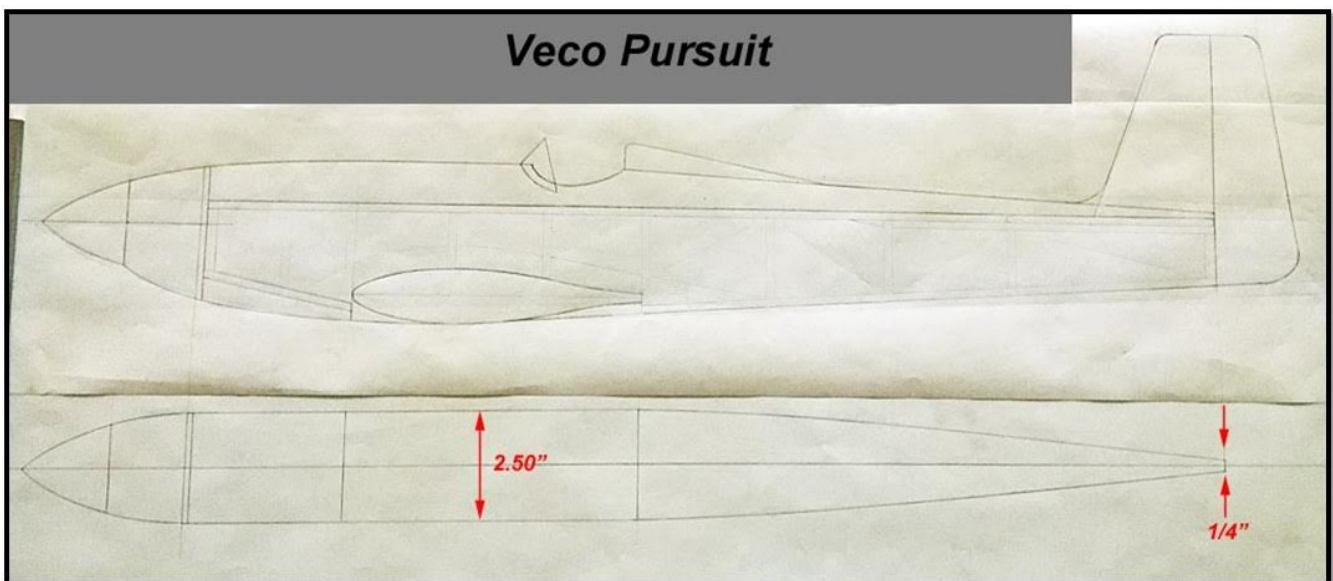

The full size drawing of the fuselage profile shown below was developed last Saturday. Since that time I have been tied up with other activities including another minor surgical procedure.



However yesterday afternoon, I did manage to get the fuselage's top view drawing laid out as shown below. The fuselage width is held constant at 2.50" back to the trailing edge of the wing before it starts to taper down to a 1/4" at the tail post. I still have to decide whether the fuselage sides will be 1/8" sheet balsa or a structure built up out of 3/16" sq. balsa.



I have recently noticed trying to draw up these plans that the vision in my left eye has become modestly cloudy which has degraded my close up focusing significantly. I have an appointment with the ophthalmologist next Wednesday, on August 4th to find out what is going on. I suspect that the covering over the implanted lens in my left eye has become cloudy. I understand there is a laser optical procedure to resolve the cloudiness issue. However, I will have to wait see what my left eye problem is first.....Tandy
