

# January Meeting Happenings....

Prez Alan had a few engines on display.







Sam Niece showed a source for flight surface control cable. It is from a bead making supply, Beadalon (beadalon.com). The cord is ridged with very little stretch( which is very important for limiting slop on the control surfaces). There is also a crimper and the crimp bead (or tube) to form the loops at the end of the pull-pull cable.



The one Sam showed is a 7 strands with a diameter of 0.015", it came in a 30 feet spool.



There is also this stranded fishing leader material, It is made of steel, has 7 strand and 10 lb test strength. The wire has a diameter of 0.012".

## **Cover Story: Sokol 465G**

Sokol 465G was designed by Bronislav Sokolicek in 1946 as a rubber powered model. The plan was redraw by Gabor Gitye, who has graciously let us use the plan to produce a kit in the U.S. The plan was obtained through a friend, Laszlo Torok. A few people (Jay Burkart, Dennis Tyson, Rick Holman) were involved in the process to make it a cutting file for laser cutters. The kit is now available from Bob Holman Plans. The design is a big winner in the Electro Rubber Class in SAM World Championships in Hungary. The Sokol 465G will fit nicely in the US SAM 2025 rules for Electro Rubber class.

#### 2025 Electric Rulebook Section 10

Electro Rubber LMR Rules (Electro Rubber) is a Championship Event, replaces rule #4 Wakefield event from previous SAM rules book.


4: Electro Rubber LMR entries shall be any SAM approved Rubber designs meeting current SAM cutoff dates powered by an electric motor. Landing gear is as original design functionality. Scaling is allowed. Minimum ready to fly weight of the model is 12 oz. Model may be hand launched. Motors are limited to a Hacker A10-15S without modification. Folding props allowed as well as prop savers. Batteries are limited to 2 series cell lithium chemistry cells of any Flight time starts on aircraft capacity. release from hand launch and terminates when aircraft contact the ground or groundbased object. The motor run time limit may be reduced at the discretion of the CD. The motor may run only during the first 90 seconds of the flight. The Contestants score will be the best two of three attempts. A Max flight time is 10 minutes.




Chip Showed the fuselage of a Blériot XI he is building from a kit.
