- CD can rearrange schedule based on weather conditions.

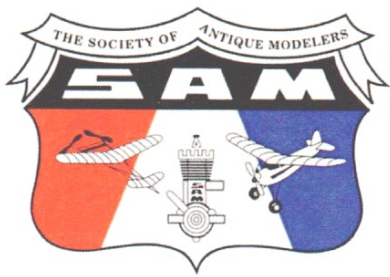
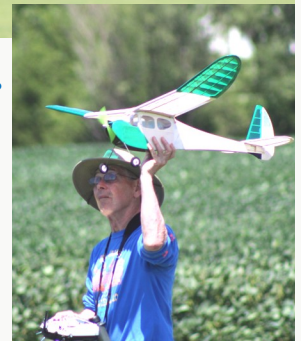

SAM Midwest Champs 2024 Event Planning

From Tom Boice: The 2024 SAM champs planning is in full swing. We hope as many of you as possible will attend. We have made a few small rule changes to help increase participation in all RC events. We hope to increase the number of participants and flights by allowing more than one contestant to fly the same plane in an event. If more than one contestant maxed out with the same plane only one contestant would fly in the fly off. This would allow two good friends or a father and son team to participate in more events. The second special rule is to allow smaller LER planes to fly with the larger planes. Example an A sized plane could fly in the B and C class events. The smaller sized planes would have to conform to the rules of the B or C events they flew in.

This would allow a contestant to fly one or two planes in all the championship events. The overall glow and Ignition championship will be shortened because of having a three day event instead of five days.

The Glow championship will have three events: A&B combined, C Glow, and Texaco Glow. Ignition overall championship will be: A&B combined, C Ignition, and Texaco Ignition. Awards will be presented for first through fifth.

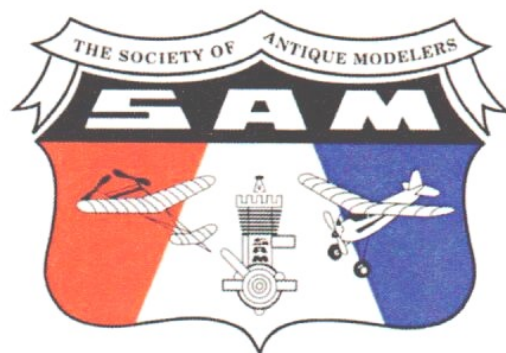

Special RC Event Notes for Fuel and Electric Events:

1. Section 1 H - Same model may be entered multiple times in the same event by different contestants.
2. All pre 1963 gas and electric model designs accepted as Old Timers.
3. Class A engines may be entered in Class B & C LER events with applicable event Max flight times.
4. Class B engines may be entered in Class C LER events with 9 minute Max flight times.
5. Acceptable in the Ohlsson 23 event: Ohlsson .19s, glow or spark engines, hand launches.
6. 1/2 A Scale models accepted in 1/2 A Texaco event, minimum weight 16 ounces.
7. Required minimum weight for all glow models: 156 ounces times engine displacement in cubic inches.
8. Electric special event for 36" Electric Replica run by Jack Hiner on Thursday.
9. All Electric Events are standard per the rule book. The exception is more than one person can fly the same airplane. The Spirit of SAM can be flown at dawn Wednesday.

Accommodations:

Hotels Close by - Holiday Inn Express 8 miles East of down town Ft. Wayne near I-469 at 11205 Isabelle Dr. New Haven, In. 46774. Richards restaurant is next door.

Fort Wayne International Airport is the largest airport near our flying field. Indianapolis International Airport is about three hours South of Fort Wayne. Also Muncie Indiana home of the AMA is about one and a half hours South of Fort Wayne.

Tuesday after our flying events Tom is planning a barbecue at the field club house. Wednesday evening dinner will be at the Halls Factory restaurant located at 5811 Coldwater Road, at the SW corner intersection of Washington Center Rd in Fort Wayne Indiana. Thursday after the events are flown we will have award presentations at the field.
