It is pretty cold here in north Texas today, which is good building weather. It is too cold to dope on the T-Bird fuselage today and the Johnson .26 gaskets have not arrived from Burnis Ray yet so I can not complete the engine's assembly. Therefore, I decided to start the framing the Big Bomber's right wing tip panel (*Do you realize it was September the 12th that I e-mailed you my last Bomber construction report No. 48*). The picture below shows what I was able to accomplish so far today. The blue clamp is holding the elevated joint between the formed right wing tip spline and 3/8" square leading edge and the joint must dry thoroughly before I continue. So I stopped for the day and took this picture to show you. You can see the wing's center section and left wing tip panel in the back ground that will make up the wing's 96" span. I really do not have a lot left to do on the Bomber before I can start covering it.....Tandy
