*Cleveland Cloudster 600**July 16, 2020*

I received my order for the Great Planes 2-1/4" spinner shown below in yesterday's afternoon mail.



The spinner's aluminum back plate and an 11 X 7E APC prop was bolted on the AXI motor prop adapter. Then the spinner was screwed on to the back plate. The distance from the rear face of the spinner back plate to the rear face of the X motor mount was measured as 1.75". The front of the fuselage's side frame was extended out to the back of the 1/8" firewall as shown below in red. This reduces the size and length of the cowl and eliminates the requirement for a motor spacer. The contour of the cowl shown below really gives the front end of the fuselage a nice finished look..... Tandy
