

Today while I was waiting on the fuselage bulkhead patterns to arrive from Alfredo, I framed up the horizontal tail as shown below. The plans called for 3/32" thickness wood, but one of the changes Mike Midkiff made was to increase the wood thickness to 1/8" and re-space the ribs. This meant having to cut out new tip parts out of 1/8" sheet balsa......Tandy
