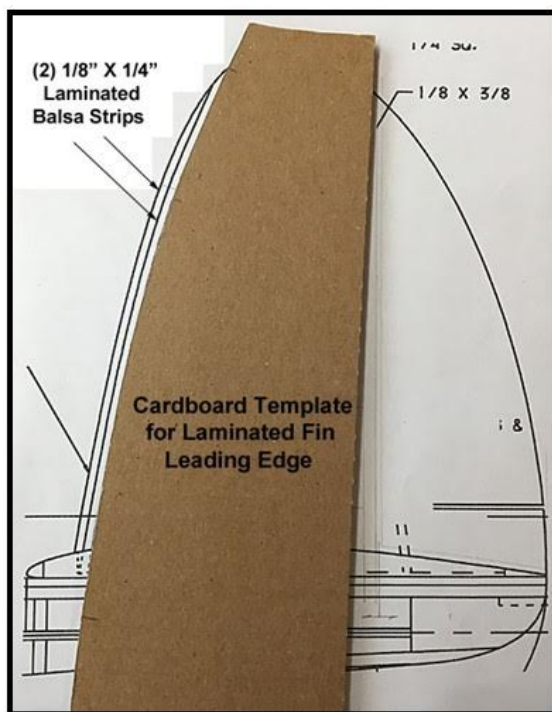

As you may recall, one side of the heavy cardboard template used in making the stab's leading edge earlier was reshaped to make the template for the fin's leading edge which consisted of laminating two pieces of 1/8" X 1/4" balsa strips as shown below.



However, after removing the fin's laminated leading edge from the cardboard template, I discovered that it slightly straightened out a little. I guess a two part lamination with only one glue seam will do this while a multi-part lamination with several glue seams will hold its shape and not straighten out. In an attempt to try and put in a little more bow, I broke the lamination as you can see below. To eliminate this straightening problem, the template was trimmed down from the black line to the red line to provided more curvature to the lamination. Now when the lamination straightens out a little, it should just about take on the desired contour.....Tandy
