I am still in the middle of doing our taxes, but I received two deliveries in the mail yesterday that I want to share with you. I placed an order for more Polyspan Lite as I discovered that I did not have enough Polyspan Lite to finish the Rocketeer A's first base covering. The first delivery was a 6' X 39" sheet of Polyspan Lite shown below from Larry Davidson. All you have to do is let Larry know what you want and he will have it in the mail to you almost immediately. By the way, I had to put the Canon lens cover you see in the middle of the picture so the camera would have something to focus on.



I was running low on the GEM single edge razor blades, which I use exclusively in all phases of modeling, especially when covering. Since I can no longer find them here in north Texas, I called John Marcosky to find out who he gets his GEM blades from. John steered me to a web site called "drugstore.com" who had them for \$4.99 for a package of ten blades, which is quite reasonable. I think I paid almost \$6 for the last ones I bought at a Walgreen's store. I ordered six packages shown below and got free shipping. They also arrived in the mail yesterday.
