On a previous project, I e-mailed Nate Dickerson of the Klass Kote company to find out about Klass Kote curing time. I indicated that I was planning on letting the Klass Kote dry for several days or maybe even a week before proceeding on with the project. I also noted that Klass Kote looks better and better as it dries (or cures) with time, but that I had no idea how long it takes for Klass Kote to "fully cure" or "set up". Nate responded with the following information:

Tandy,

At 70 degrees F, sward hardness (full cure) is 4 - 7 day. Allow 7 to be sure. Lower temperatures require longer curing times. Attached is our Product Data Sheet - the cure schedule is defined under the Cure Schedule section.
