Handy Switch for Chargers

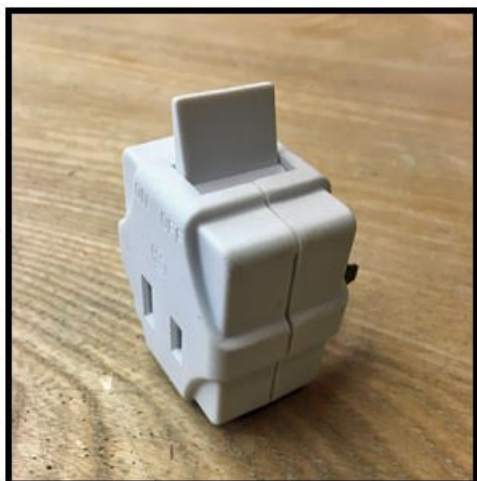

I have been working with my new Hitec X2ACPlus charger shown below the last few days and I really like using it. However, there is no way to turn the power off without unplugging the AC power cord. None of my other smart chargers have an on/off switch either.



I was in our local ACE hardware store the other day and saw this small compact ceramic on/off switch shown below. The two metal tangs on the back plug into a wall socket and a power cord can be plugged into the front of the switch. The wide toggle lever on top turns the switch on and off.



So I bought one and took it home. I plugged the switch into the extension cord between the wall and the cabinet and then plugged the charger's AC power chord into the front of the switch as shown below. This now permits me to turn the charger on and off with a flip of the switch and eliminates having to plug and unplug the charger's power cord.....Tandy
